The story begins with the arrest of the twin brothers Jean and Michel, their younger sister Suzette and their parents. After being released on their own the siblings must figure out how to find food on the black market, hide an Allied aviator named Jack and elude the Nazis. They join forces with a resistance friend, Lucie, and her grandmother while dodging her despicable collaborator uncle. Jean finds and promptly falls in love with another girl from their resistance network, Marielle, who's been left with two scrappy younger brothers to care for. Once they decide to trust elderly neighbors, they find themselves smuggling military secrets and fighting on the barricades during the liberation. By the end of the war they have created a new extended family of teenagers and seniors who support each other both physically and emotionally.


Drawing on her background as a professor of modern European history, Koreman crafts a narrative grounded in historical accuracy. The characters and events are all based on true events Koreman found in the archives, providing readers with an authentic window into the civilian experience of World War II.

Allary Éditions publishes one volume per year, nine volumes in total. Each volume covers one year in the life of Esther, from her 10th through to her 18th year, and each volume contains 52 stories for the 52 weeks of the year.

Volume 1 (10 years old): Esther is 10 years old. Who are Tal, Kendji Girac, and the Hotheads? What are the criteria of beauty that make young boys and girls popular? What can you do when your friends have more money than you? How did Esther's class feel about the attacks in Paris in January 2015? What do you do if you're worried about your breast size?

Volume 2 (11 years old): Esther is 11 years old. She tells us about the birth of her little brother, the terrorist attacks, the boys she is in love with, religious discussions with her best friend, her teacher with dwarfism, her mother who suddenly gains weight, her idiot big brother and her father the hero...

Volume 3 (12 years old): Esther is a 12-year-old student in a prestigious college in the center of Paris. She is now a preteen! The presidential elections, her first cell phone, her hamster Manuela, the arrival of acne, her conspiring brother, her left-wing partisan father, her far-right voting grandmother, President Macron, the Illuminati, and her love for sausage-apricot cake... Esther talks about everything!

Volume 4 (13 years old): Esther is now 13, she leaves childhood and enters adolescence... In this volume Esther talks about her dental braces, the French #metoo movement, her long-gone dreams, her secret boyfriend Ben, her friends, her family...

Volume 5 (14 years old): Esther is now 14 and starts to take an interest in politics (just a little) wonders how we can live normally while the homeless sleep in the streets, and learns Spanish, thanks to her penpal Nacho. Of course she listens to Angèle, and imagines that all the young people in the world will save the Earth by joining hands.

Volume 6 (15 years old): It's the year Esther turns 15 and enters ninth grade, her last year in middle school! She reconnects with her BFFs Éva and Léa, puts up with some overly feminine girls who have been left behind, organizes her first big birthday party (with alcohol!), tries a cigarette and (finally) creates her Instagram profile, which inevitably attracts psychopaths. Then everything is thrown into chaos by the coronavirus... it's lockdown time.

Volume 7 (16 years old): Esther is in tenth grade! This is the year she turns 16. Everyone smokes; it's almost like a "drug empire." Some of her friends are anti-vax. She still gets vaccinated by a fireman better looking than Timothée Chalamet. Her body changes – not because of the vaccine. She has to make choices and invent her future life. To make some pocket money, she starts babysitting and even becomes a camp counselor.

Volume 8 (17 years old): Esther is 17 years old. It's almost time for her final French exams and Esther is wondering about her future: why not give up her studies altogether, in fact, LOL? And become a bookseller? To live among books? But apparently, it pays less than being an Instagrammer, so it's tricky... And then Putin, the bald dictator, attacks Ukraine, and war breaks out. What if it happened to us in France too?

Final Volume 9 (18 years old) is forthcoming in June 2024.


